Performance time in front of the Judges will be limited to one song for bands and one minute for dance groups and marching units. This must be strictly enforced in order to limit the parade duration. All commercial entries must be accompanied by a float.

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third place in the categories of dance, floats, bands, marching units, equine, cars and commercial floats. A "Best of Show" trophy will be awarded in the category of Emergency Services Vehicles.

We will be contacting you with your placement number in the parade on November 29, 2010.

All participants are asked to carpool to the parade grounds as space is very limited.
